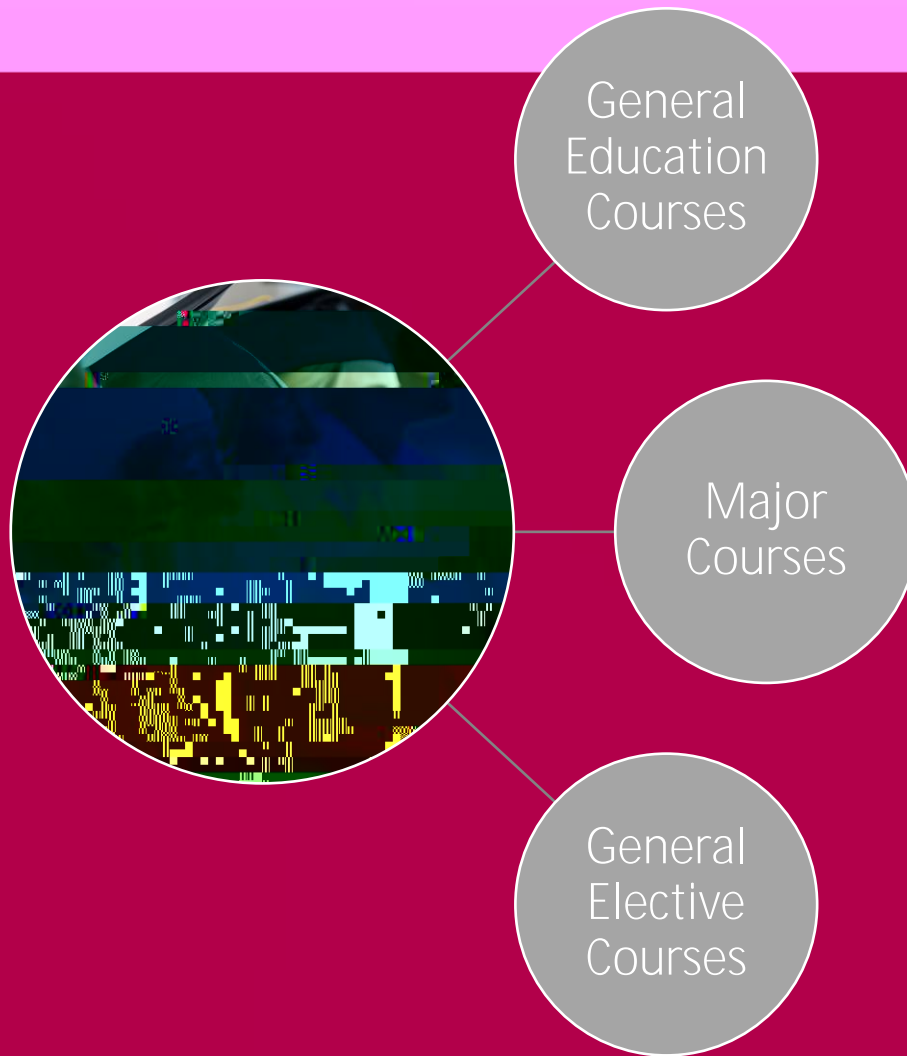

Most courses are 3 credit hours.

1 credit hour workshops, labs and field experiences also are offered.

128 credit hours = Approx. 43 courses

To earn credit hours for a course, students need a certain grade. If they do not earn that grade they will have to re-take the course to earn the credit.

Electives

Students must maintain a certain grade point average each semester.

0-33 credit hours = Minimum 1.75 GPA

34-50 credit hours = Minimum 1.90 GPA

51+ credit hours = Minimum 2.00 GPA



Earn at least a 2.5 GPA.

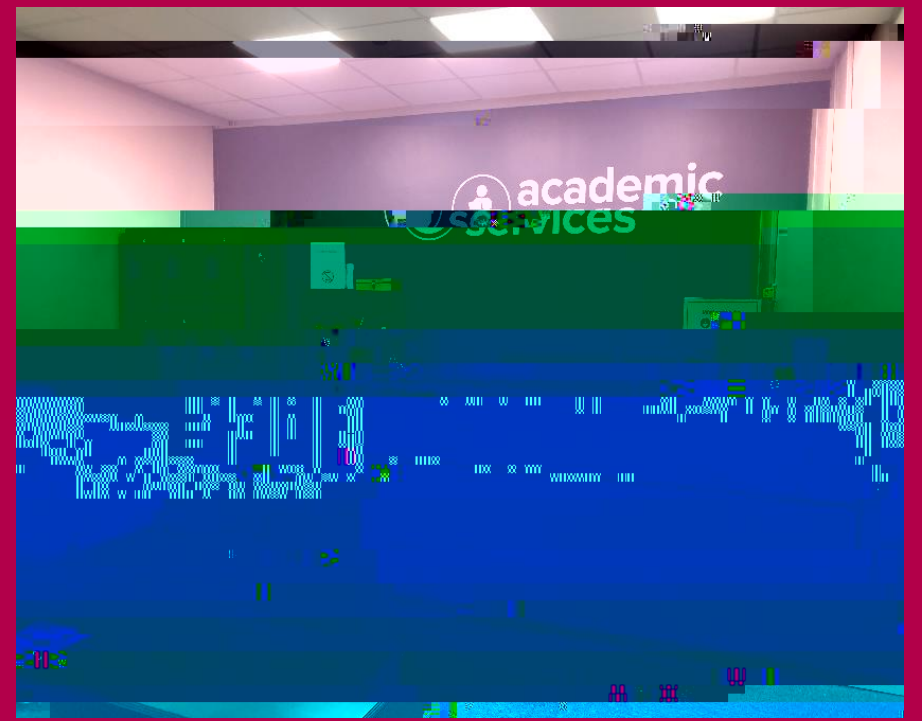
